8 Precipitation is also snow

9 and hail,

10 freezing rain

11 or ice.

11 The water from the land changes into moist air

12 and it goes up into the sky.

13 When the moist air turns back into water it's

15 Even the fog?

16 And the thunderstorms?
17 Even hurricanes?!
18 Watch out for the strong winds and rain!
All (Hurricane sound effects)
19 Does the sun even make tornadoes?
1 Uh-huh.
2 What's a tornado?
3 A tornado is a spinning windstorm.
4 A tornado sounds something like this.
All (Tornado sound effect)
5 The weather person on TV tells us the
temperature.
6 Who knows what temperature is?
All I do! Me! I do!
7 What?
All Temperature is how hot or cold it is.
8 Right!
9 There are all kinds of weather.
10 There are 4 seasons of weather.
All Winter, spring, summer, and fall.
11 Some days are sunny.
12 Some days are icy.
13 Some days are partly cloudy.
14 Some days are snow days.
All No school! Yay!
15 Some days are foggy.
16 Some days are hot.
All (sound effect and use scripts as fans)
17 But.....
All Whether the weather is cold,
or weather the weather is hot,
we'll weather the weather
whatever the weather,
whether we like it or not!*
